After students have been nominated for the exchange, they will receive an email with the link to the online application platform, called Mobility Online. They need to upload the required application documents on Mobility Online.</p>

Nomination Deadline	<p><i>Fall Semester or full academic year: 15<sup>th</sup> of March</i></p> <p><i>Spring Semester: 15<sup>th</sup> of September</i></p>
Application Deadline:	<p><i>Fall Semester or full academic year: 30<sup>th</sup> of March</i></p> <p><i>Spring Semester: 30<sup>th</sup> of September</i></p>
Number of candidates	<p>2 J.D. students per academic year. The official period of stay as an exchange student can be of one semester or – if both institutions agree – for one academic year.</p>
Language Requirements	<p>Good German or English language skills are recommended.</p>
Admission Confirmation	<p>Students will receive a letter of acceptance and further information on studying at the UZH from the GSE UZH after their application has been accepted.</p>
Semester Fees	<p>Semester fees will be paid at the home university only.</p>
