REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIALS

Application for Admission

The application for admission should be completed in its entirety to the best of your ability.

Essay Questions

In place of a traditional personal statement, applicants will be asked to respond to two essay questions.

Resume

The resume you include in your Northwestern Pritzker Law application should include professional, education, and leadership experiences you feel are relevant to your candidacy.

The Law School Credential Assembly Service

The Law School Credential Assembly Service (CAS) report contains a summary of each applicant's:

- Post-Secondary Transcript(s)
- At least one Letter of Recommendation or Evaluation
- Results of the Law School Admission Test (LSAT)
 - The Two-Year JD program requires a valid LSAT score. The GRE will not be accepted.

Evaluative Interview

Interviews provide the Admissions Committee with additional information about your communication skills, maturity, and motivation.

Application Fee

A nonrefundable application fee of \$75 is required to submit your application.
