

**APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION CHECKLIST FOR:

REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIALS

Application for Admission

The application for admission should be completed in its entirety to the best of your ability.

Personal Statement

Provide a one- to two-page statement on a topic of your choosing. The statement provides an opportunity to introduce yourself to the admissions committee and provide information about your background, experience, skills and/or goals.

Resume or Curriculum Vitae Written in English

The resume you include in your Northwestern Pritzker Law application should include professional, education, and leadership experiences you feel are relevant to your candidacy.

The Law School LLM Credential Assembly Service

The Law School Credential Assembly Service (CAS) report contains a summary of each applicant's:

- Post-Secondary Transcript(s) Translated into English,
- TOEFL or IELTS Score Report,
- At least one Letter of Recommendation or Evaluation.

OPTIONAL APPLICATION MATERIALS

Evaluative Interview

Interviews provide the Admissions Committee with additional information about your communication skills, maturity, and motivation. Admissions interviews are optional but are strongly encouraged.
