As provided by the Crime Awareness and Campus Security Act of 1990, now known as the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act, you are entitled to request and receive a copy of a Northwestern University's Annual Security Report. Reports are available for the Chicago / Evanston, Miami, Qatar and Washington, DC campuses. These Reports includes statistics for the previous 3 years concerning reported qualifying Clery Act crimes that occurred on campus; in, as applicable, certain off-campus buildings or property owned or controlled by Northwestern University; and on public property within, or immediately adjacent to and accessible from campus. The Reports also include institutional policies concerning campus security and safety on topics such as crime prevention, the reporting of crimes, sexual assault, emergency preparedness and other matters.
